

Photography Certificate Portfolio Requirements 2009

- *Candidate must have taken each image.*
- *Images must have been taken during or between course enrollments.[After 6/1/2010, must be taken while registered as a Certificate Program student]*
- *Images may be color or black and white prints.*
- *Images may be digitally enhanced. Significantly altered images shall be clearly labeled with an explanation or list of processes used.*
- *Images may be either a portrait or landscape orientation.*
- *Images shall be sized between 8" x 10" and 20" x 30" (art requiring non-standard proportions must have no dimension shorter than 8" or longer than 30").*
- *Images must be mounted on exhibit board between 11" x 14" (smallest) and 20" x 30" (largest).*
- *Images may be matted and/or framed (optional)*
- *Image or mats may be signed and dated (optional).*
- *Images must have a support fashioned to support the image when, a) placed on a tabletop or b) hung on a flat vertical surface such as a wall.*
- *Images remain the property of the photographer.*
- *Any sale of images will take place away from University property.*
- *UGA reserves the right not to display any images that the Professional and Personal Development faculty/staff determine to be of a questionable nature for a public, family-friendly exhibit. PPD decision is final. Full-frontal nudity and violent or graphic images may not be exhibited; partial nudity must be pre-approved.*
- *Student should choose an advisor to assist in the preparation of the images.*
- *The portfolio will generally contain a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of twenty (20) images; however, this may vary with the location and circumstances of the exhibit and the number of students exhibiting together.*
