Exhibitor Set-Up Instructions

1. Know your exhibit ID number (you should receive this information by email). Your exhibit ID number is also your booth number.
2. When you arrive at the Classic Center, proceed to the grand exhibit hall.
3. Go directly to your booth and set up.
4. An identification card is located in the lower corner of your exhibit space. When you are completely setup, you should sign your exhibit ID card and then you are free to leave the building.
5. Make sure you are back at your project promptly at 12 p.m. No parents/guests may accompany you.

Other things you should know:

- Your project may be set up Thursday evening. It must be set up by 9:30 a.m., Friday, March 30, 2012.
- Do not allow any part of your project to protrude beyond your allotted boundaries (1/2 table).
- Boxes and packing materials, etc., may be placed under the table at your own risk.
- A copy of the Safety and Display rules is at the Help Desk if you have questions.

Important: Safety Review Check - The Safety Review Committee will inspect all projects after set-up on Friday. They will sign your exhibit ID card if you are cleared to exhibit your project without any changes. If you have a problem, a red notification card will be at your project. If you receive a red card, please see a member of the GSEF staff. This means you have a setup violation that must be resolved.
