Athens, Georgia, is located about 60 miles northeast of Atlanta. Athens is served by two airports: Athens-Ben Epps Airport is 10 minutes from campus and offers connecting flights through Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport; the Atlanta Airport is located about 90 minutes southwest of Athens, with scheduled ground shuttle service and rental car service available.
