Keith J. Karnok, Ph.D., professor of agronomy at the University of Georgia, is the project developer, editor, and author of the course. With more than 30 years of warm- and cool-season turfgrass experience, Karnok has authored more than 250 publications in turfgrass management and is a frequent speaker at regional, national, and international turfgrass educational programs. Karnok is well recognized in his field both nationally and internationally. He has a B.S. in agriculture and an M.S. in agronomy from the University of Arizona, and earned a Ph.D.

in Agronomy from Texas A&M University. Karnok has attained the status of "Fellow" in the American Association for the Advancement of Science, Crop Science Society of America, American Society of Agronomy, and the North American Colleges and Teachers of Agriculture. Fellow is the highest honor bestowed by a scientific society. His teaching awards include the "Josiah Meigs Award for Excellence in Teaching," UGA's highest teaching honor.

Gil W. Landry, Jr., Ph.D., professor (retired) of turfgrass management and coordinator for the Georgia Center for Urban Agriculture at the University of Georgia, is the author of more than 350 articles related to turfgrass science and is a regular presenter at national and state conferences. He has a B.S. in general agriculture, an M.S. in agronomy, and a Ph.D. in agronomy from Louisiana State University. For more than 24 years, Landry has been responsible for the development and implementation of statewide Extension Turfgrass Management educational programming for UGA. He is a member of the International Turfgrass Society, the American Society of Agronomy, the Crop Science Society of America, the Sports Turf Managers Association (STMA; past president), the National Association of County Agricultural Agents, and the Council for Agricultural Science and Technology. Landry is a recipient of STMA's highest award — "The Harry C. Gill Memorial Award."



Bert McCarty, Ph.D., is a professor of horticulture at Clemson University, specializing in turfgrass management with emphasis on weed control and growth regulators. He is author and coauthor of more than 300 publications. McCarty is a member of several professional associations related to turfgrass management. A native of Batesburg, SC, he received a B.S. in agronomy and soils from Clemson, an M.S. in crop science from North Carolina State University, and a Ph.D. in plant physiology and plant pathology from Clemson.
