Apply for the National Youth Science Camp (11th & 12th grade)

GSEF exhibitors in grades 11 and 12 are invited to apply to be selected as a Georgia delegate for the 2023 National Youth Science Camp (NYSCamp), held in a hybrid format **June 19 to July 12, 2023**, with the first 5 days virtual and the remaining 2.5 weeks of the camp held in-person at Camp Pocahontas in West Virginia.

Hosted in Monongahela National Forest in West Virginia since 1963, the National Youth Science Camp (NYSCamp) is a residential science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) program designed to honor and challenge some of the nation's rising leaders and provide them with opportunities to engage with STEAM professionals and participate in exciting outdoor activities.



The 2023 NYSCamp will feature a **keynote lecture series** presented each weeknight during the virtual portion of camp and twice a day on most days of the in-person camp. These world-class lectures are presented by prestigious and up-and-coming STEM professionals who are making a difference in their fields of study and changing the world for good. Delegates will have the opportunity to join the lecturer for a 30-minute interactive **Q&A session**. Informal **evening hangouts** will be offered each weeknight during the virtual portion of the camp. These will be replaced by evening cabin meetings in during the in-person portion of camp.

Other programming at camp will allow delegates to delve deeper into STEM topics with experts and knowledgeable enthusiasts in multi-day mini-courses (**directed studies**) or interactive 60 minute **seminars**, take **tours** of facilities like the Green Bank Observatory and National Gallery of Art, learn new **hobbies and skills**, and engage with camp staff in program areas that will range from practicing languages, yoga, or mindfulness, playing games, discussing compelling topics, making art or music, or learning outdoor skills. Delegates will also be able to participate in the NYSCamp outdoor program which includes camping, hiking, caving, and mountain biking.
