### Apply for the National Youth Science Camp (11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade)

GSEF exhibitors in grades 11 and 12 are invited to apply to be selected as a Georgia delegate for the 2024 National Youth Science Camp (NYSCamp), held June 29 through July 20, 2024 at Camp Pocahontas in West Virginia.

Hosted in Monongahela National Forest in West Virginia since 1963, the National Youth Science Camp (NYSCamp) is a residential science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) program designed to honor and challenge some of the nation's rising leaders and provide them with opportunities to engage with STEAM professionals and participate in exciting outdoor activities.

The 2024 NYSCamp will feature a **lecture series**, during which delegates participate in world-class lectures by STEM experts on a wide range of innovative and relevant topics. Speakers are selected from among prestigious and up-and-coming STEM professionals who are making a difference in their fields of study and changing the world for good. **Directed studies** provide opportunities to delve deeper into a topic with an expert.

For a bit more fun, **seminars** are informal interactive experiences with someone who is knowledgeable and passionate about a topic. Past seminars have included juggling, cooking, practicing a language, and playing Ultimate Frisbee on the green. The mountains of West Virginia are a perfect location for the **outdoor adventure program**. Guided by experienced outdoor staff, delegates have ample opportunities to hike, backpack, rock climb, and go caving, kayaking, or biking during camp. All delegates also participate in overnights with various levels of physical challenge. The delegations also travel to **Washington, DC** where they can meet congressional members, tour museums, and attend a panel discussion held at the American Association for the Advancement of Science.
