Images/Photographs of Plants

In general, while viewing smaller still images, you may click on the image to see a larger view and a new window will open. Depending on your monitor's resolution, the image could take the entire screen. You can then either minimize the image or close the window, and you will be seeing the same small image that you clicked on.

In some cases there will be series of related images together, like a slide show. You will find instructions on how to move from one image to another or directly to a specific image.
